

Black Walnut Tolerant Trees & Shrubs

Black Walnut Tree's produce a chemical called <u>juglone</u>. Toxicity symptons arise when juglone-sensitive plants are placed within the walnut's root zone, which can reach 50-60 feet from the trunk of a mature tree.
