

DROUGHT TOLERANT PERENNIALS

Dry soils are difficult places to plant. These plants should be able to tolerate this type of condition better than others. Improving the soil by adding organic material and mulching will also help.

Please keep in mind that these plants DO need to be watered regularly for the first year until they get established.
